



WHAT IS ENRICHMENT?

Enrichment is a Friends of Sutton PTO fundraiser, in which a variety of classes are offered after school for students in grades K-5 to expand their learning experiences beyond the classroom.

WHEN IS ENRICHMENT?

The first session of Enrichment will take place: **Wednesdays -- October 6, 13, 20, and 27**, with a makeup day of November 3 if needed. The second session of Enrichment is scheduled to take place in March 2022.

HOW DO I SIGN UP A STUDENT FOR ENRICHMENT?

Registration will be available **online** for 1 week only through a link on the school website: **Friday, Sept 17 - Friday, Sept 24.**

HOW DO I PAY FOR ENRICHMENT?

The cost for each student to participate is **\$50**. Financial assistance is available - please contact Ms. Merriam or Mrs. Harrison! There are two options to pay:

1. Send a Check in Your Child's Homework Folder: Checks should be made out to Friends-PTO of Sutton Elementary. You may send 1 check for multiple children. Please include the child(ren)'s name(s) on the check.

AFTER SCHOOL ENRICHMENT CLASS DESCRIPTIONS FALL 2021

Crafty Fun with Foods (Grades: Kindergarten-2nd) Children will enjoy sampling some snacks while creating edible fall artwork and will also design their own aprons for cooking at home! Please be advised we will be using/tasting food, so if your child(ren) have a particular food allergy or sensitivity, let us know at the time of registration.

Fairytale Fun (Grades: Kindergarten-2nd) Be a creative critter as we enter the world of fairies, gnomes, and other favorite fairytale creatures. All you need is a little love, luck, and fairy dust! Each week we will read a different magical tale, create another fantastical craft - including a fairy house and more - and maybe even experience a little fairy magic!

Fun with Legos (Grades: Kindergarten-2nd) Do you want to join the ranks of Lego Master? We'll provide the Legos and you provide the creativity! Come prepared for some Lego challenge activities as well as just pure building fun.

Heroes Among Us (Grades: Kindergarten-5th) The Sutton Police and Fire Departments will be leading this special class. So if you want to learn more about what a "Day in a Life" of a police officer or firefighter really looks like, come meet some of Sutton's special heroes.

Karate (Grades: Kindergarten-3rd) Martial Arts with Sensei Sarah will instill and reinforce the basic core values of respect, courtesy, and politeness. With practice, skills are developed and strength of character is achieved as agility, power, and speed are improved. This class focuses on cooperation, teamwork, and respect all while having fun!

POP! (Paint Our Pottery) (Grades: Kindergarten-3rd) Paint a new piece of pottery each week. Pick your colors and start painting. We will bring the pottery, you bring the artistic vision! Please pack an old shirt to throw over your school-day clothes.

Run for Fun (Grades: 3rd-5th) Aimed at helping kids enjoy running, this class will incorporate warm-ups, stretching, and fun running activities each week. We will *not* be running long distances, but will be working on technique, form, and pacing. Bonus: by joining the class, students will be extra ready for the Sutton Fun Run (to be held Tuesday, November 9th). All skill levels are welcome. Please wear comfy clothes and sneakers.

Secrets of Minecraft (Grades: 3rd-5th) Learn to play Minecraft like a pro! This class will be led by Sutton students with years of Minecraft experience combined. They will demonstrate some of their favorite Minecraft secrets and let you share yours as you play together virtually in a Minecraft World using individual school Chromebooks. Come ready to build, create, and discover new worlds in the Minecraft Education Edition.

Sewing with Grandma (Grades: 3rd-5th) Learn the basics of hand sewing and the foundation necessary to support a lifelong love of crafting. Thread a needle. Sew on buttons. Learn different stitches and take home your projects each week -- e.g., scrunchies, pencil cases, and more!

Spooky Green Bean Club (Grades: Kindergarten-5th) Join the Green Bean kids for the month and explore spooky theater games, Halloween-themed characters, and haunted mini-stories - maybe even have a monster dance party! Open invitation to share your *spooky* acting at the PTO's Outdoor Halloween Event is included as part of this Enrichment class.

Watercolor Painting (Grades: 3rd-5th) Calling all artists! Join us while we explore the fun of watercolor painting. We will dive into different painting techniques and styles all the while making artwork to bring home. Weather permitting, we may paint outdoors.

Wood Workshop (Grades: Kindergarten-2nd) If one weekend a month at Home Depot is not enough for you aspiring builders, then wood workshop is for you. Each week you will assemble a new project all on your own. Let's get out those hammers and start building!

Yoga (Grades: 3rd-5th) Kids Yoga teaches the practice of yoga, breathing, and mindfulness in a playful manner. Children will develop body awareness, learn to manage stress through breathing, self awareness, and healthy movement, and will build concentration and focus. Mrs. Gara, a registered yoga teacher with over 20 years of experience, will share her love of yoga with students.
